Traffic awareness yellow jacket drive was organised by the lions of District 317F under the leadership of Lion Sumanth, DC, Traffic Awareness. Considering the heavy load of traffic in Bangalore, the related aspect of road accidents, as well as the

bureaucratic indifference of law makers and keepers, this event is of prime importance. School children, the Bharath scouts and guides and other institutions have organised walkathons about road safety. On New Year's Eve the GIG workers (Blinket, Zepto, Swiggy, Instasmart, and Flipcart Minutes among others) had a nation-wide strike which highlighted widespread concern over road safety, long working hours, low pay, life threatening risks and lack of job security. "DELIVERY IN 10 MINUTES" has been the culprit in rash and speed driving. Union Labour Minister Mansukh Mandaviya urged quick commerce companies to abandon rigid timelines and priorities, as it leads to hazardous strain on delivery personnel. Many quick commerce companies and state governments, including Karnataka have complied. GIG workers are known to jump traffic signals and ride on pavements to meet the time deadlines. It is now upto consumers not to insist on speed of delivery. No delivery is worth risking one's life.
